

**RESOLUTION NO.**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRFAX TOWN COUNCIL IN SUPPORT OF MEASURE B,  
A MEASURE PROVIDING FOR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS IN MARIN COUNTY  
THROUGH A TEN DOLLAR VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEE**

**WHEREAS**, Measure B will generate approximately \$2 million dollars each year for transportation improvements in Marin County; and

**WHEREAS**, 40% of the proceeds will be dedicated to cities and towns for use to maintain local streets, roads and paths; and

**WHEREAS**, 35% of the proceeds will be used to improve transit for Seniors and people with disabilities by expanding transit options through Para transit and other support services; and

**WHEREAS**, 25% of the proceeds will be used to reduce Congestion and Pollution through commute alternatives, Safe Routes to School programs, crossing guards, EV charging stations, etc.; and

**WHEREAS**, fees raised may only be used to pay for programs and projects that bear a relationship or benefit to the owners of motor vehicles paying the fee and are consistent with a regional transportation plan; and

**WHEREAS**, local administrative costs are limited to no more than 5 percent of the fees collected;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Fairfax Town Council endorses and supports passage of Measure B on the November 2, 2010 ballot, a measure providing for transportation improvements in Marin County through a ten dollar vehicle registration fee.
