**A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRFAX TOWN COUNCIL SUPPORTING FUNDING FOR  
PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING STUDY FOR THE  
EAST WEST (CROSS MARIN) BICYCLE CORRIDOR**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Fairfax has adopted a Complete Streets resolution which emphasizes and supports walking and bicycling as healthy, environmentally sound, and cost effective modes of transportation; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Fairfax has been a leader in the Safe Routes to School program which emphasizes early childhood and youth walking and biking to school to cultivate sustainable health and environmental benefits for the community;

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Fairfax desires more walking and bicycling intermodal accommodation; and,

**WHEREAS**, the East-West bike corridor from Fairfax to San Rafael has the demographic capability of supporting a viable bicycle and pedestrian corridor which will get significant usage and reduce automobile trips and associated environmental risks; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Fairfax was the lead agency in the Fairfax to San Rafael Cross Marin Trail Study; and,

**WHEREAS**, the County of Marin will be allocating funding for additional programs and projects through the Non Motorized Pilot Program;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town of Fairfax requests \$500,000 from the County to bring all of the Short Term and Medium Term alternatives to Preliminary Engineering from the completed Fairfax to San Rafael Cross Marin Study, which was funded with a previous Non Motorized Pilot Program grant; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Town of Fairfax requests to be appointed as the lead agency for this Preliminary Engineering project.
