We are thankful for the support of the police Chief Chris Morin and understand that closure of the block is inconvenient for some. Therefore, we will do our best to minimize the time it will be closed. We will also be sure to inform all participants to park their vehicles in the pavilion and ball park lot and not on nearby residential streets.

By securing the permission of the Town Council early, we are certain to again fill the total designated spaces. Consistent with past events, our goal is to have fun while raising as much money as we can. We will again, through the help of our local businesses and sponsors, be providing recorded music with a DJ, selling popcorn and drinks, giving out goody bags that include gifts and coupons, and raffling off donated gifts. No alcohol will be served or permitted in or around the area.

This year, again, our main sponsor will be the Rotary Club of Ross Valley. They were eager to share in our efforts to have this event in order to raise funds for local programs. Programs for the children of our town will be at the top of the list again. **A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FAIRFAX
AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BROADWAY FROM PACHECO
TO BOLINAS ROAD TO ALLOW A CAR SHOW ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2011**

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of Ross Valley is sponsoring the ninth annual Classic Car Show on Sunday, September 11, 2011; and

WHEREAS, temporary closure of certain streets is necessary in order to safely facilitate the exhibition of cars; and

WHEREAS, the Parkade and a portion of Broadway are needed for the Car Show;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Fairfax to temporarily close the following:

The entire Parkade from 6:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., with the applicant to provide three parking monitors at the Good Earth parking lot during the show hours, and a portion of Broadway from Pacheco to Bolinas, with access to the Fairfax Theater parking lot to remain open, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Sunday, September 11, 2011.
