**Subject: Report on the Status of the Presence of PCE at the Fair Anselm Retail Center**

**DISCUSSION**

UPDATED INFORMATION:

According to DTSC's project management team for the Fair Anselm Center Site, DTSC has finished gathering data for the video survey of the sewer line, the geophysical survey to assess subsurface conditions, the cone penetrometer tests and hydro punch samples outside of the building.

Currently, DTSC is assessing where the soil gas samples should be taken and how they should be taken. Data from the geophysical survey has given additional insight about the subsurface conditions, and DTSC staff is discussing modifications to the soil gas sampling in response to this information. Getting started on the soil gas investigation is taking longer than the DTSC expected because it was not given enough information about the data collection methods in the work plan. The DTSC project manager is currently discussing this issue with support staff, and this information will be communicated to the consultant so he can provide an addendum to the work plan.
