RECOMMENDATION

Adopt Resolution No. 12-64, a Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Fairfax authorizing the release of Revised Plans and Specifications for the Sir Francis Drake Bike Lane Striping Project.

BACKGROUND

The Town of Fairfax was awarded a Non-Motorized Transportation Pilot Program (NTPP) grant for this project. The original bid package included some street widening and no bids were received for the project. Subsequently, Maggiora & Ghilotti completed the street widening and minor paving portions of the Bike Lane Striping Project with funds remaining from the 2012 Street Rehabilitation and Paving Project and the project was reconfigured as solely a striping project. Paul Wade, Project Engineer, advised that more bids would be likely with a striping only project without the street work included. A new bid package has been prepared that includes just the striping on Sir Francis Drake.

The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$31,242, and the additive alternate is \$13,045.

FISCAL IMPACT

Depends on the bids received. We have budgeted \$59,895 for this project and have spent \$20,105 to date.
