

Press Release: Town of Fairfax, 1-3-12

The Fairfax Town Council will consider approval of a contract with Garrett Toy as the new Town Manager at their meeting on Thursday, January 10<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Toy has over 23 years of experience in municipal government managing projects and programs from creation to completion. He was a member of the senior management team in Morgan Hill for 13 years. As the Director of Business Assistance and Housing Services, he oversaw Morgan Hill's Redevelopment, Economic Development, and Affordable Housing activities, while managing annual budgets ranging from \$40 million to \$70 million, including capital projects. During his tenure, he facilitated the establishment of the Morgan Downtown Association and Property Based Improvement District. Mr. Toy also assisted the City Manager with the management of the Community Development Department and served as the City's budget officer preparing the City's \$110 million operating and capital budget. Currently, he is the Administrative Services Manager for the County of Marin's Community Development Agency where he is responsible for the Agency's financial, budgetary, and personnel functions for over 80 staff. His previous experiences include serving as the Deputy Director of Housing and Redevelopment for the City of Stockton and working for the City of Fairfield's Department of Planning and Development. He has a Masters of Public Policy and a B.A. degree in legal studies from the University of California at Berkeley. He lives with his wife and two daughters in San Rafael. He plans to begin serving as the Fairfax Town Manager on February 4, 2013.
