**Subject: Resolution No. 13-12 of the Town Council of the Town of Fairfax Declaring a Police Department Vehicle as Surplus to the needs of the Town, and Authorizing Disposal of Same by Public Auction**

**RECOMMENDATION**

Adopt Resolution No. 13-12 declaring the Police Department 2006 Ford Crown Victoria as surplus, and authorizing sale by public auction.

**DISCUSSION**

The Police Department's 2006 Ford Crown Victoria is seven (7) years old, and is due to be cycled out of service as it is no longer optimally functional for the police. It will be replaced with a Dodge Charger like the other two Chargers the department owns, and the 2006 Ford Crown Victoria will be declared as surplus.

It is customary procedure to declare by Resolution such vehicles as surplus, and dispose of them through public auction or bid.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

Sale of the 2006 Ford Crown Victoria will provide short term savings, and help offset the cost of a replacement vehicle.
