**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FAIRFAX
AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BROADWAY FROM PACHECO
TO BOLINAS ROAD TO ALLOW A CAR SHOW ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2013**

WHEREAS, the Rotary Club of Ross Valley is sponsoring the tenth annual Classic Car Show on Sunday, September 8, 2013; and

WHEREAS, temporary closure of certain streets is necessary in order to safely facilitate the exhibition of cars; and

WHEREAS, the Parkade and a portion of Broadway are needed for the Car Show;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Fairfax to temporarily close the following:

The entire Parkade from 6:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and a portion of Broadway from Pacheco to Bolinas, with access to the Fairfax Theater parking lot to remain open, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Sunday, September 8, 2013.
