

Dear Mayor and Town Council:

Herewith I submit my application for membership on the Town Planning Commission. While I did not want to publish my home address on the public application, I want you to know that I am a 33+ year Town resident and live on Bothin Road.

For many years I was on the famous Bothin Road Float team, and have long enjoyed our lovely town, nestled as it is in the Marin hills and green trees. I don't want that to change and I hope that the enclosed will convey that attitude.

My practice has been to give back to my community. From 1987- 1994 I volunteered for the Board of the San Rafael BID (Business Improvement District) where I helped improve Downtown by upgrading the entire district to foster business and defeat crime. As an attorney on the BID I mediated between the Mayor's Office and Police, and Fire, and Paramedics, and Public Works and the SR Chamber. All of this has led to events to attract people to the Downtown as a destination and to limit the advance of potential crime. That BID created the Downtown Farmers Market Festivals, Subaru Bike races, May Madness Car show, and the Italian Street Painting Festival. Much as the Fairfax Farmers Market and Festival do that here. I hold a San Rafael Award of Appreciation for this.

In law school in 1979 I wrote a paper entitled "*Solar Home Energy the Future is Now*" and have long been a "green" advocate. The General Plan for Fairfax calls for solar to be installed wherever possible. I believe this can be done artfully and can lead to a sustainable town. My undergraduate degree is a BA in Political Science/Public Administration. That BID experience brought real meaning to that UCLA education. I want to bring this knowledge to our Town and help out here.

Recently I had the pleasure of being the attorney who cleaned up an old but liked polluter, by the sale to one of my clients of the IJ Building, where I helped eliminate years of hazmats from a
