**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FAIRFAX
COMMENDING MARY ANN MAGGIORE FOR FOUR YEARS OF
OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO THE PEOPLE OF FAIRFAX AS A TOWN
COUNCIL MEMBER**

WHEREAS, MARY ANN MAGGIORE has been a fully engaged and active member of the Town Council since her election in 2005; and

WHEREAS, MARY ANN MAGGIORE'S service to the Town officially began when she was appointed to the Planning Commission where she served with diligence until stepping down to assume her role on the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, MARY ANN MAGGIORE served as Mayor during her term, and, as Mayor, organized a very successful and first in the area "Small Town Mayors Conference" hosted by Fairfax; and

WHEREAS, MARY ANN MAGGIORE is responsible for the establishment of the Fairfax Youth Commission, a logical result of her desire to involve youth in the programs offered by the Town and to acknowledge the significance of the youth in the community; and

WHEREAS, MARY ANN MAGGIORE has earned the respect of many citizens in Fairfax for her passionate support of democracy and its principles, something that prompted her to start the tradition of conducting a community reading of the Declaration of Independence on the Fourth of July in Fairfax; and

WHEREAS, MARY ANN MAGGIORE, as a Council Member has served as a Fairfax representative to the Ross Valley Fire Board, to the Transportation Authority of Marin, on the Affordable Housing Committee, the Youth and Alcohol Task Force and the Community Development Block Grant Committee, as well as other assignments; and

WHEREAS, MARY ANN MAGGIORE leaves office with the heartfelt thanks of the Town Council and the citizens of Fairfax.
