

PROCLAMATION

**CONGRATULATING THE HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETES WHO
QUALIFIED FOR AND COMPETED IN THE 2009 NATIONAL
MOUNTAIN BIKE CHAMPIONSHIPS IN COLORADO**

WHEREAS, the sport of cross country mountain bike racing requires dedication and long hours of training in order for athletes to excel in races that cover twenty miles of rough terrain; and

WHEREAS, from January to May, high school athletes compete in a series of cross country races throughout northern California; and
