**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FAIRFAX  
AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A PORTION OF GLEN DRIVE FOR A BIKE RACE FUND  
RAISER ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2010, FROM 8 AM TO 5 PM**

WHEREAS, the Parent Club of White Hill Middle School is sponsoring a Cyclocross Race as a fund raiser for the school;

WHEREAS, temporary closure of a portion of Glen Drive is necessary in order to safely facilitate the event; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Fairfax to temporarily close Glen Drive from the driveway at White Hill School to the beginning of the open space at the end of Glen Drive from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for a fund raising bicycle race event.

**TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE/DEFINED**

A block party or similar occurrence not exceeding one city block on other than arterial or collector streets, and along which at least two-thirds of the area is in a residential zone. A majority of owners/residents/tenants must consent to closure. Event must be sponsored solely by such owners/residents/tenants, and not be for commercial or advertising purpose or profit.

**CONDITIONS OF CLOSURE**

APPLICANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING AND REMOVING SUCH BARRICADES/BARRIERS AND WARNING SIGNS NECESSARY TO CLOSE THE STREET SAFELY. Police Department barricades are only made available when the closure is immediately adjacent to an arterial street. Half of the roadway's width for the entire length of the closure shall remain clear of objects (BBQ's, tables, etc.) in order to accommodate public safety vehicles in the event of an emergency. Applicants must provide for the collection and removal of all trash, garbage and litter caused by or arising out of such temporary street closure. Event activities shall not create a public or private nuisance or an undue hazard or disturbance to the public peace, private nuisance or an undue hazard or disturbance to public peace, tranquility, health, welfare, safety or morals, or create an excessive burden on police or fire or other public operations equipment or facilities. The Town's noise ordinance is enforced on a complaint basis. Block party permits provide no waiver to the noise ordinance. In the interest of safety, permits will not be issued for times of darkness. Alcoholic beverages shall not be consumed or sold in conjunction with the closure.



**PLEASE NOTE:** *The Town does not generally require applicants to provide proof of insurance for block party activities which take place on public property. However, the Town does have specific insurance requirements for those who seek to place jumping tents, animal rides, etc. on streets or sidewalks. Applicants will be contacted if any activity they propose requires proof of insurance.*

12. As applicant's of the proposed closure, I/We certify that a majority of owners/residents/tenants of properties fronting on such streets have consented to the closure. I/We also certify that we have reviewed the "Conditions of Closure" and "Temporary Street Closure/Defined" and understand the restrictions which apply to neighborhood block parties. I/We are also aware that Temporary Street Closures can be immediately revoked if Penal Code Section 415 (disturbing the peace) or if applicable Town of Fairfax codes regulating noise or alcohol are violated.
