Subject: Authorization to Release Plans & Specifications to Bid for the Sir Francis Drake Boulevard Slurry Seal Project.

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Release of Plans & Specifications to Bid for the Sir Francis Drake Boulevard Slurry Seal Project.

DISCUSSION

On December 22, 2006, the Town was awarded federal funding in the amount of \$103,000 for pavement repairs on Sir Francis Drake Boulevard from Oak Manor to June Court. The project description includes pot hole repairs, a slurry seal finish coat and restriping.

Plans and Specifications were submitted to Caltrans and approved on March 13, 2008. The plans and specifications are now ready to be released for bid.

Plans and specifications are available for review in the office of the Town Clerk.

FISCAL IMPACT

The engineer's estimate of probable cost is \$109,800 for construction and construction engineering. The project was approved by Council in the FY 2009/2010 Capital improvement budget. \$103,000 will be reimbursed through the federal grant and the matching funds of \$6,800 will be paid out of Measure F funds.
