The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. The minutes were approved.

1. **New Business**

1. **Parkade banner advertising future site of parkade mural** – Chris submitted a banner he prepared with the help of his son. The banner is made of canvas, and has the language “Future site of parkade mural, call 456-5652” painted on. PARC had tasked Chris with preparing this banner as a way to advertise the mural he hopes will be painted on the parkade parking lot wall in the future. **ACTION ITEM: PARC recommended the banner go to the Design Review Board, now part of the Planning Commission and that the applicant fee be waived. Maria will talk with Linda Neal about scheduling this item for the next Planning Commission meeting on July 19th.**

**Old Business**

1. **Peri Park update-** Anne submitted a report to Maria on the outcome of the Peri Park clean-up and bocce ball court painting, which occurred on June 2<sup>nd</sup>. Maria distributed the report to PARC members. It was suggested that the next park clean-up occur in early October.
2. **FOCAS Update** –Maria announced that she participated on an interview panel with Anne Mannes for the position of summer camp director. Monica Burrowes was selected for the position. She is a highly qualified candidate with a Master’s degree in Public History. She has held a variety of jobs, including working for the Governor’s Office, and the Marin History Museum. She is a local Fairfax native. Camp will run from July 23<sup>rd</sup> through August 17<sup>th</sup>. There are currently 15 children registered for Camp Fairfax.

3. **Artists-in-Residence update** - Shoshana Parry inquired as to whether the sign ordinance could be waived or amended to allow signs for Town sponsored events to go up around town. Maria responded she would check with the Planning Department, who oversees the sign ordinance.

### **Committee Reports**

1. **Pavilion Clean-up project** –Elon suggested postponing the clean-up of the Pavilion until after the remodeling construction has occurred on the building. It was agreed it would make sense to put the clean-up day off until the fall months.
2. **Tree Committee**- Monty & Elon offered to serve as alternates to the Tree Committee when Richard is unavailable. Maria will notify Susan Waters of this change.
3. **Fairfax Festival Committee update** –Maria stated a financial report had been submitted to the Finance Department from Meredith Law.
