PARC Commissioners in attendance: Richard Pedemonte, Monty Stephens, Sisi Parry-Hanson, Lisa Taylor. Staff in attendance: Anne Mannes, Recreation & Community Services Manager, Programming, Maria Baird, Recreation & Community Services Manager, Events.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. The August minutes were approved.

**New Business**

1. **Public Art at Parkade**-Maria announced she has been contacted by several artists who are interested in exhibiting at the Parkade. The first is Sandi Cohn, whose metal sculpture is entitled “Tin Man”. Maria went to Sandi’s residence to view the art piece, to determine if it is eligible for placement at the parkade. The piece is relatively large and heavy. Sandi inquired if there is any assistance with moving the piece, Maria replied no. She also inquired if there is any stipend offered, and again, Maria replied no. **ACTION ITEM: PARC voted to approve the placement of “Tin Man” at the parkade, for a 3 month period. Maria contacted Peaceman, and asked him to remove the pagoda type fencing around the art display area. He will do so, and also help Sandi get her artwork to that location.**
2. **Bicycle Pump Track** –The Town is awaiting feedback from Alex Fowler of Action Sports Construction, on the compaction of the proposed pump track, and the distance from the creek, to determine environmental impact on the surrounding area. Once this information is obtained, further analysis will be done. If the bicycle pump track goes forward, some mitigation measures that were proposed by PARC members include: adding second bocce ball court for seniors, a tranquil senior garden, either at the Women’s Club, or Claus Circle, changing the name from “bicycle pump track” to “Kiddie Coral”.
3. **Wine & Cheese “Speak Cheesey”- Sept. 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Women’s Club** – Sisi will send information to Maria to put on the Town’s website. They will put up large signs in Bolinas Park and at the Chamber’s bulletin board. Tickets are \$30 each.
4. **Artist-in-Residence recruitment**- Maria announced she has received one application so far, from Sierra & Sara Salin. The deadline will be extended by several weeks to allow for more application submissions.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m. The next meeting will be on October 10<sup>th</sup> .
