Modification of MAMM Delivery System proposal
April 7, 2010

To the Town of Fairfax;

After considering the concerns of the Chief of Police regarding a licensed delivery system in Fairfax,

I contacted a professional medical supply delivery service from the East Bay.

Their company regularly dispatches their 6 vans, each with load of medical supplies valued at \$20,000+, on a daily basis. (See flyer from "Liberty Medical Supplies").

The amounts of medical cannabis products contained in a MAMM delivery vehicle would be valued at approximately \$5,000 or less.

After consulting with the manager of Liberty, I propose a minor change to my plan.

I would like to add the following conditions to my proposal:

~Any MAMM delivery vehicle(s) will have two persons working together as a team.

~One person will be a licensed and insured driver.

~The other person will be a qualified member of the MAMM collective, to handle the medical cannabis products.

I believe that this change, which is similar to what they do at Liberty Medical, will address the security and safety concerns expressed by Chief Hughes.

On another point regarding security and safety, the Town has a misconception regarding Little League.

First of all, our Members are very respectful of families and children, and have always been so.

In fact, because families, kids and coaches are in the area on Little League days,

we have all observed that it stops any public smoking of cannabis by anyone, around town or in the parks.

Thus, it is actually the best time to allow our facility to be open, if the Town wishes to discourage patients from medicating in park areas.

We have also had an in-house rule that suspends Members for 30 days who are caught medicating in any park in Fairfax, at any time.

There have been 2 or 3 suspensions, total, many years ago; none for smoking in the area during Little League games.

Our Members have set a sterling example of respect for the rules of the Town and our Club.

They deserve safe, regulated access at the MAMM on weekends during the daytime (now closed when notified 7 business days in advance online, up to 20 weekends a year);


and between 5 - 7pm Monday through Friday (closed during scheduled practices, up to 20 weeks yearly)

Those are the best days and best times for our business; when we are allowed to be open.

The unfair Little League restrictions have inconvenienced and discouraged a large amount of patients from coming to Fairfax, at this point, crippling the sales tax income to the Town, also.
